Meeyoung's interests include data science and information science, with a focus on modeling socially relevant information propagation processes. Her research on misinformation, poverty mapping, fraud detection, and long-tail content has received over 20,000 citations. She has received the Korean Young Information Scientist Award, AAAI ICWSM Test-of-Time Award, and ACM IMC Test-of-Time Award.

Meeyoung has worked as a visiting professor at Facebook's Data Science Team in the US and has been named the World Customs Organization's BACUDA science collaborator. She served as a commissioner for the Korea Copyright Commission, the Korea Customs Service, and the Presidential Council on Intellectual Property.

Data science is an interdisciplinary field of study that extracts knowledge and insight from diverse forms of data through the use of scientific methods, algorithms, and systems. In particular, data science based on mathematical modeling and artificial intelligence (AI) has become critical for effectively handling astronomically growing data in various fields. In this talk, Prof. Meeyoung Cha, KAIST professor and MPI-SP Director, will introduce two research themes—poverty mapping and fake news detection—that address global issues and have a social impact.

She will also talk about life as a data scientist, based on her experiences collaborating with world-class scientists at Facebook, AT&T Research, and Max Planck Institute, as well as NGOs like the United Nations Pulse Lab and the World Customs Organization.
